| | Form | Use | Example |
|-----------------------------|--------------------------------------|----------------------------------------------|--------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| 1 st conditional | if + Present Simple + will | Real & possible | <i>If you study, you will pass.</i> |
| 2 nd conditional | if + Past Simple + would | Unreal & impossible or improbable | <i>If I lived in the city, I wouldn't have a car.</i> |
| Zero conditional | if + Present Simple + Present Simple | General truths or results that always happen | <i>If milk smells bad, I don't drink it.</i> |
| would | | Preferences / requests | <i>I'd like some tea. Would you mind open the door for me?</i> |
