Relative clauses	A. who/that for people B. that/which for things C. whose for someone's possession D. where for places	The people who/that we met in France have sent us a card. Houses which/that overlook the lake cost more. He's a man whose opinion I respect. The house where we stayed was right on the beach.
Participles	Noun + participles = relative clauses	That man wearing a hat is my friend. The boys seen outside were strangers.
