Application submissions are welcome from Sunday 03/04/2023 to Thursday 02/06/2023. Final decisions will be announced on 16/06/2023.

#### How to Apply

To be eligible for the University of Babylon International Scholarship, applicants must provide full details of their course history and demonstrate, through a personal statement of no more than 500 words, their reasons for choosing the University of Babylon, how they will benefit from the course of study, and link its value to their past achievements.

These scholarships are awarded by the University of Babylon International Scholarship Committee on the basis of academic merit and outstanding personal profile as evidenced in a motivation letter. All decisions are final and cannot be appealed.

The scholarships cannot be combined with any other University bursary or awards.

**IMPORTANT: Only completed applications accompanied by all supporting documents will be considered. Incomplete or late submissions will not be accepted.**

## Terms and Conditions

1. The scholarship is offered strictly to full-time registered students at the University of Babylon upon settlement of the first semester. It is mandatory that the recipient completes the entire duration of the course.
2. The duration of the scholarship is up to the completion of the study period specified by the University of Babylon.
3. If an application is successful, applicants must confirm that they accept the award within 14 days. The university reserves the right to withdraw the offer of a scholarship if it is not confirmed by the given deadline.
4. Applicants must show proof of their baccalaureate or its equivalent for the undergraduate programs, and a suitable bachelor degree for the postgraduate scholarships.
5. Candidates should join the academic course at the given start date and before the registration deadline.
6. Applicants who defer their studies will not be eligible for the future scholarship.
7. The scholarships apply to the year of admission, not the year of application.
8. In case of any changes in circumstances, accepted students must inform their college in writing at the earliest opportunity.
9. Should a student leave their course due to medical reasons or unavoidable circumstances, his/her scholarship may be retained. It remains subject to the absolute discretion of the University of Babylon, and only after the recipient has provided adequate supporting medical documents acceptable to the University.
10. In the event that the recipient withdraws from the programme, or is suspended or terminated by the University at any point of time before the completion of the programme, the scholarship shall be automatically terminated.
11. Should such a withdrawal, termination, or suspension occur, the University of Babylon reserves the right to claim for the recovery of fees due, which are calculated on a pro-rata basis. This is based on the valuable benefit received by the recipient.
12. By submitting an application form, successful applicants are giving their consent to the University of Babylon to hold and process their data in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. The applicant's information, including their name and photographs, may be used for publicity by the University. If the applicant does not give consent to the data being used in this way, they must let the University know in writing at the time of submitting the application form.
13. The University of Babylon reserves the right to involve the scholarship recipients in interviews, advertisements, photography, or other publicity-related activities for the purpose of promoting the educational institutions.
14. Scholarship awards are made by the University of Babylon Scholarship Panel and all decisions are final and cannot be appealed.
15. All students are required to comply with, and are bound by, the University's Student Regulations and Procedures, which can be viewed at the university website.
16. Non-compliance to any of the terms and conditions related to the relevant scholarship would result to a breach of contract.
17. University of Babylon reserves the right to withdraw scholarships without earlier notification in case the applicant is subsequently found to be ineligible or if these terms and conditions are not adhered. In the event of a dispute on the eligibility for the scholarship, the decision made by the University of Babylon is final.
18. Should the recipient accept any other scholarship, this scholarship will be terminated automatically.
19. The university reserves the right to amend its scholarship provision without notice.
