

Background : The nursing process is a method that is used by nurses during the planning of nursing care, and requires scientific reasoning, not just skills. The nursing process encourages nurses to reflect on their practice of care and provides a Guarantee that the care, the patient is receiving, is consistent with scientific breakthroughs in the science of nursing (LeFevre, R. A., & Garcez, R. (2007) .

The nursing process enables the nursing students to quickly identify the nursing interventions that need to be carried out on ill patients, (Garcia, T. R., & Nóbrega, M. M. L. (2000)

Objective : To assess the nursing student university of Babylon knowledge related to nursing process .

Methodology: Descriptive-cross sectional study design selected to assess the nursing student knowledge related to nursing process form the period between (15 Sep – 2021 to 25 April -2022), (164) student selected to participate in the study for data collection special questionnaire to reach the objectives of the study which contents (23) multiple choices question and another form prepared to assess student responses which consist (11) items .

Results: The results show that most of the study sample 97 (59.2%) were between age group (19-25), 95 (57.93%) were female and 90(54.9%) were from morning program morning, most of the sample recorded poor knowledge related to nursing process .

Conclusion: Most of the study sample shows poor knowledge related to all domains of nursing process while they recorded high responses regarding nursing process .
