

Background :Nasogastric tubes are widely used in the world's nasogastric intubation is a medical process involving the ,hospital insertion of a plastic tube (Nasogastric tube or NG Tube) through the nose, past the throat, and down into the stomach. Orogastric intubation is a similar process involving the insertion of a plastic tube (Or ogastric Tube) through the mouth. Nasogastric feeding is usually considered as the first line in artificial nutrition support for patients with a functioning gastrointestinal tract whose nutritional needs cannot be met by diet alone or by diet and nutritional supplements. [Sano etal,2016][Vinay H G and others,2015]

Objective :To assess the nursing students knowledge related to nasogastric tube procedure.

Methodology :descriptive-cross sechioal study design selected to assess the nursing student knowledge related to (Knowledge of Nursing Students regarding nasogastric tube procedures)from the period between. (15-septemper 2021 to 26-April 2022),(4 student selected to participate in the study, for data collection specail questionner prepared to reach the objectives of the studywhich content (21)multipal choice question.

Result :The result shows that most of the study sample 179(84.8%) were between age group (19-23) ,153(72.5%) were

female and 156(73.91) were from morning program most of the sample recorded poor knowledge related to Knowledge of nasogastric tube procedures .

Conclusion : Most of the study sample shows poor knowledge related to all domains of nasogastric tube procedures, while the recorded high responses regarding nursing process
