Background: Toxoplasmosis is a very common infectioncaused by the obligate intracellular protozoan parasiteThis parasite is called Toxoplasma gondii widelydistributed around the world . *Toxoplasma gondii* can bevertically transmitted to the fetus during pregnancy andmay cause wide range of clinical manifestations in theoffspring.

Objective: To determine seroprevalence Immunoglobulin G (IgG) and Immunoglobulin M (IgM) to *Toxoplasma gondii* among pregnant women in Babylon province.

Seventy blood samples were collected from pregnant women with spontaneous abortion, The blood samples were processed appropriately and tested for *T. gondii* IgM and IgG using ELISA technique.

Sixty out of seventy samples were diagnosed with toxoplasmosis, we result that is *T. gondii* considers one of the most common causes for abortion in pregnant women.
